Our dedicated supplier portal helps our supply chain partners interact and collaborate with our procurement teams.


The Oracle-based portal provides a secure, web-based platform where you can:

- View and update your supplier profile information.
- Receive and participate in negotiations.
- Access the latest information on any negotiations you're invited to participate in – enabling you to review the status of a submission, respond to enquiries and manage your documentation.


**Note:** as part of the sign in process, you will be required to set up multi-factor authentication (MFA). This provides an additional layer of security when accessing cloud-based applications by requiring a second step to verify your identity. Find out more about MFA <a href="here">here</a>.

Follow the steps below to sign in to our supplier portal.

 Open the system generated email from 'Microsoft Invitations on behalf of Skanska' inviting you to access applications.




2. Select 'Accept invitation' towards the bottom of the email message.



3. When you reach the Microsoft sign in screen, enter your email address and select 'Next'.



4. When prompted for more information, select 'Next'.



 When you reach the additional security verification screen, under 'Step 1: How should we contact you?', you have the option to choose your preferred MFA method.


We recommend that you select the 'Mobile App' and select 'Receive notifications for verification'. Note: this will require you to install the Microsoft Authenticator app\* (see page 6 for more details).

Once you've made your selection, click 'Set up'.



6. At this stage you will be prompted to configure the Microsoft Authenticator mobile app. Follow **steps 1 to 3** as shown below (step 1: Install the Microsoft authenticator app, step 2: In the app, add an account and choose "Work or school account", step 3: Scan the image on the screen).

Once complete, select 'Next'.




7. When prompted, select a country region and add an alternative number, in case you lose access to the mobile app. Once you've done this, select 'Finished'.



8. When you reach the 'Approve sign-in request' screen, if you selected the mobile app as your method for MFA, you will receive a notification on your mobile device to 'Approve sign-in'. Select 'Approve' to continue.




9. Once you have approved the sign in, you should be granted access to the Oracle homepage. From here, select the 'Supplier Portal' icon.


