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Skanska UK has joined with the Aker Kvaerner JV to form one of the seven members of the @One Alliance, set up to deliver the £750m Anglian AMP4 capital programme of works.

The Anglian Water programme involves the upgrade of existing sewage and water treatment plants, scattered throughout the largest geographical area covered by any utility company within England and Wales. It extends from the Humber in the north to the Thames in the south.

Skanska's design team provides key personnel embedded within the Alliance team based in Anglian Water's Peterborough headquarters and supplies civil and structural engineering expertise to the Project Development teams in the early phases of the projects.

At Project Implementation stage, the design team provides integrated civil and structural engineering designs that have been developed in close liaison with the site delivery teams to provide efficient, cost effective solutions on a site-by-site basis. During construction the close working relationship between design office and site is translated into the consistent delivery of the projects to challenging programmes and within budget. □
