Our apprenticeship application process is split into 4 stages:

## 1 Online application (CV)

2 Online psychometric assessment (Cognitive & behaviours)

**3 Short video interview** (Motivation based)

4 Assessment day
(Group task & an interview)

#### 1 Online application

Have an interesting CV with connections to the role you are applying to, for example – if you are applying for an Environmental apprenticeship, we might like to read on your CV that you enjoy following MinuteEarth on YouTube, or that your favourite subject at school is Geography.

#### 2 Online psychometric assessment

Keep an eye on your emails (including your junk inbox) and complete this within the timeframe required. Take some time to practise a few online assessments before the real deal. It'll be worth it!

#### 3 Video interview

Make sure you know why you want the apprenticeship you're applying for. Be ready to explain it to us — it's tougher than you think! Practise with a friend, teacher, or even record yourself on your phone.

#### 4 Assessment day

This is the final stage where you'll meet the team you'll be working with if you get the job. You want to make a great impression, so ask questions and enjoy the day. We usually run online prep sessions before Assessment days, so you'll know what to expect.



To create a stand out CV, add a strong personal statement summarising your goals and motivation.

Highlight activities beyond academics:

- Part-time work, volunteering, or internships.
- Insight days, research, hobbies, or interests.
- Showcase your proactive and motivated attitude.
